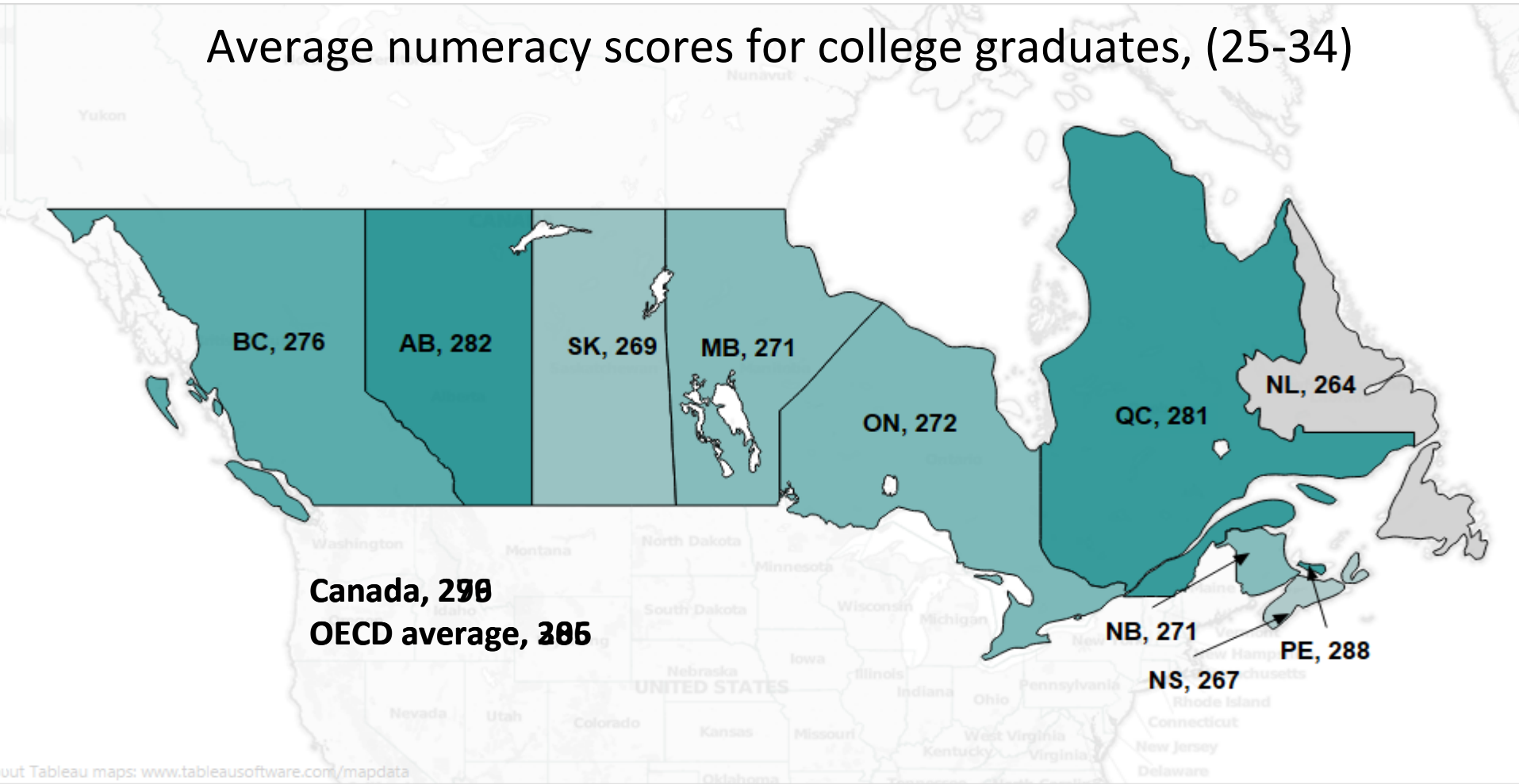

Average literacy scores for university graduates, (25-34)

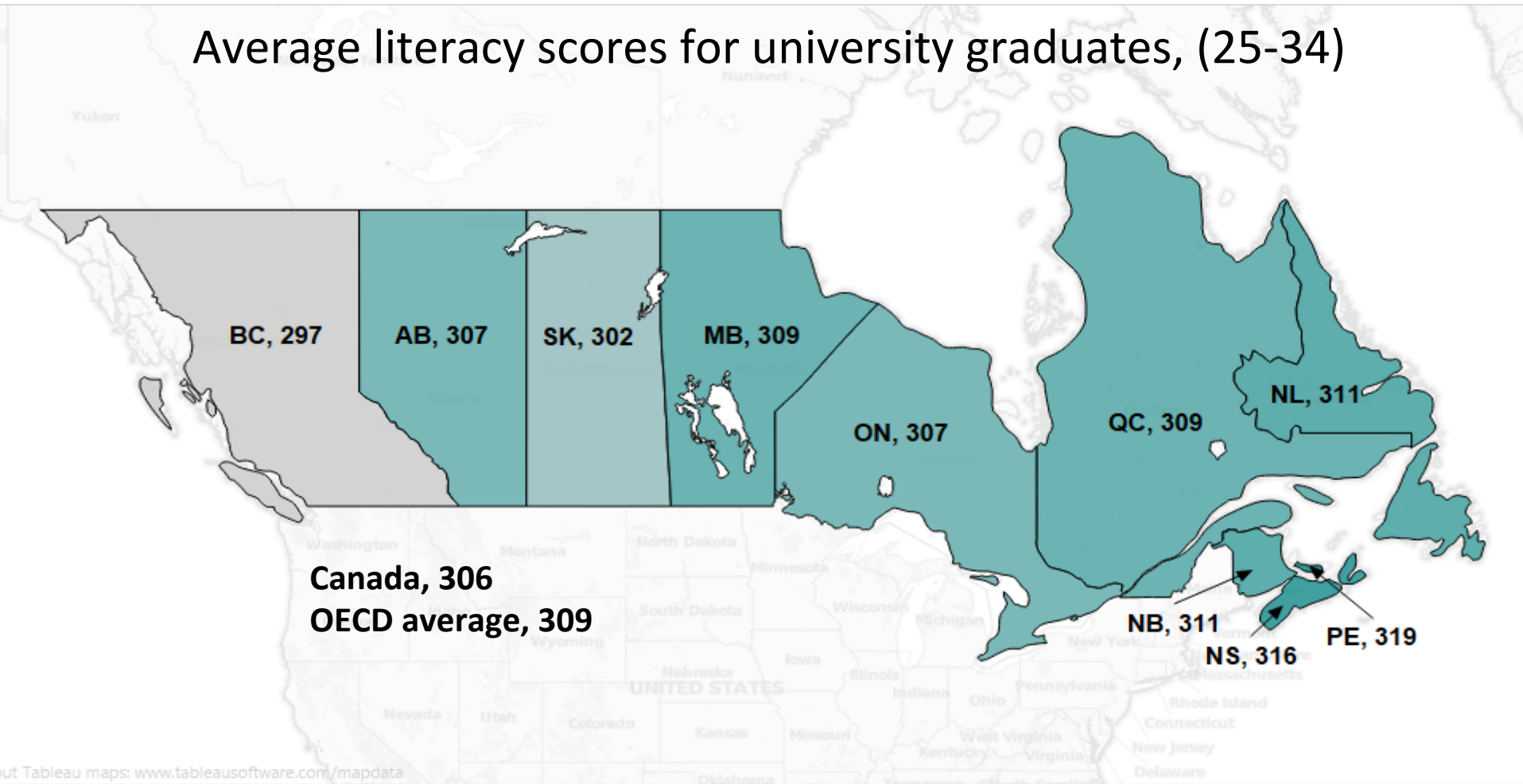
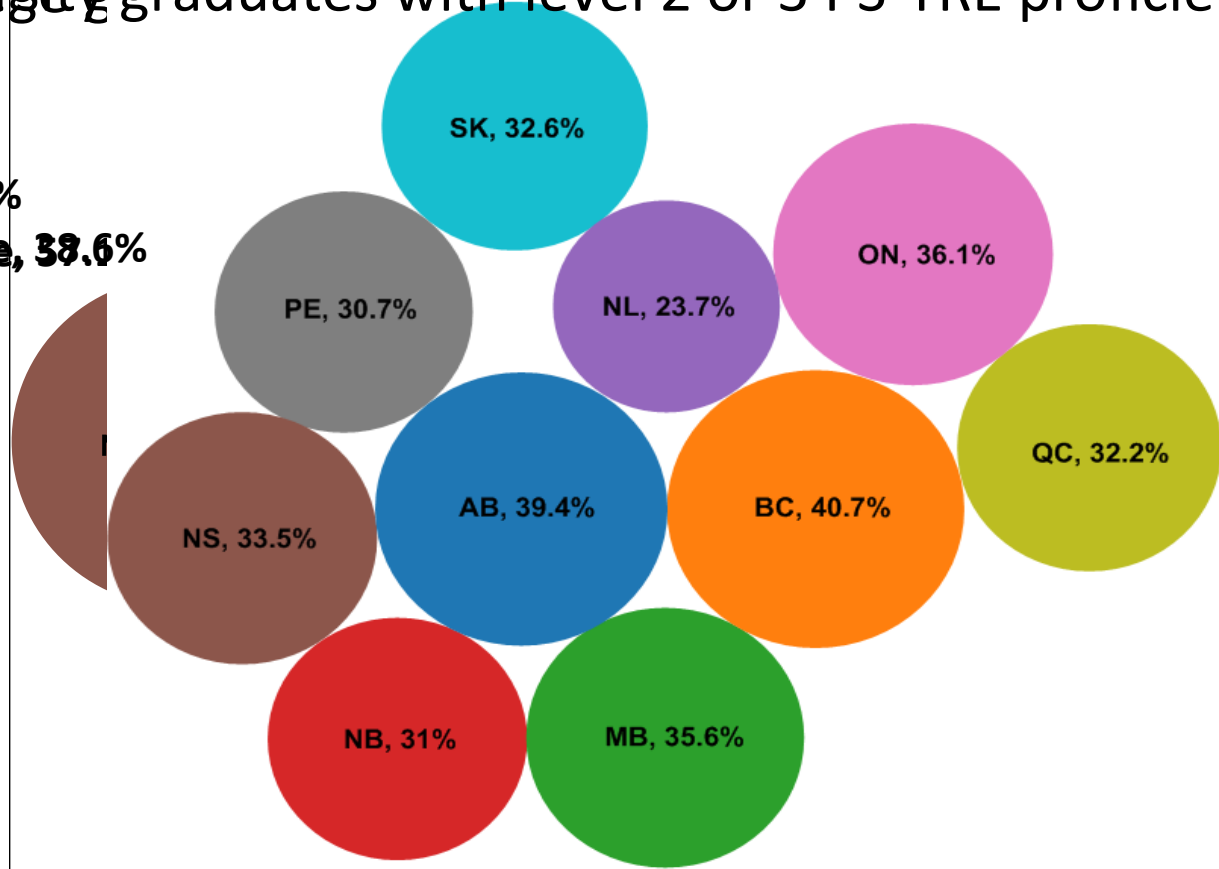

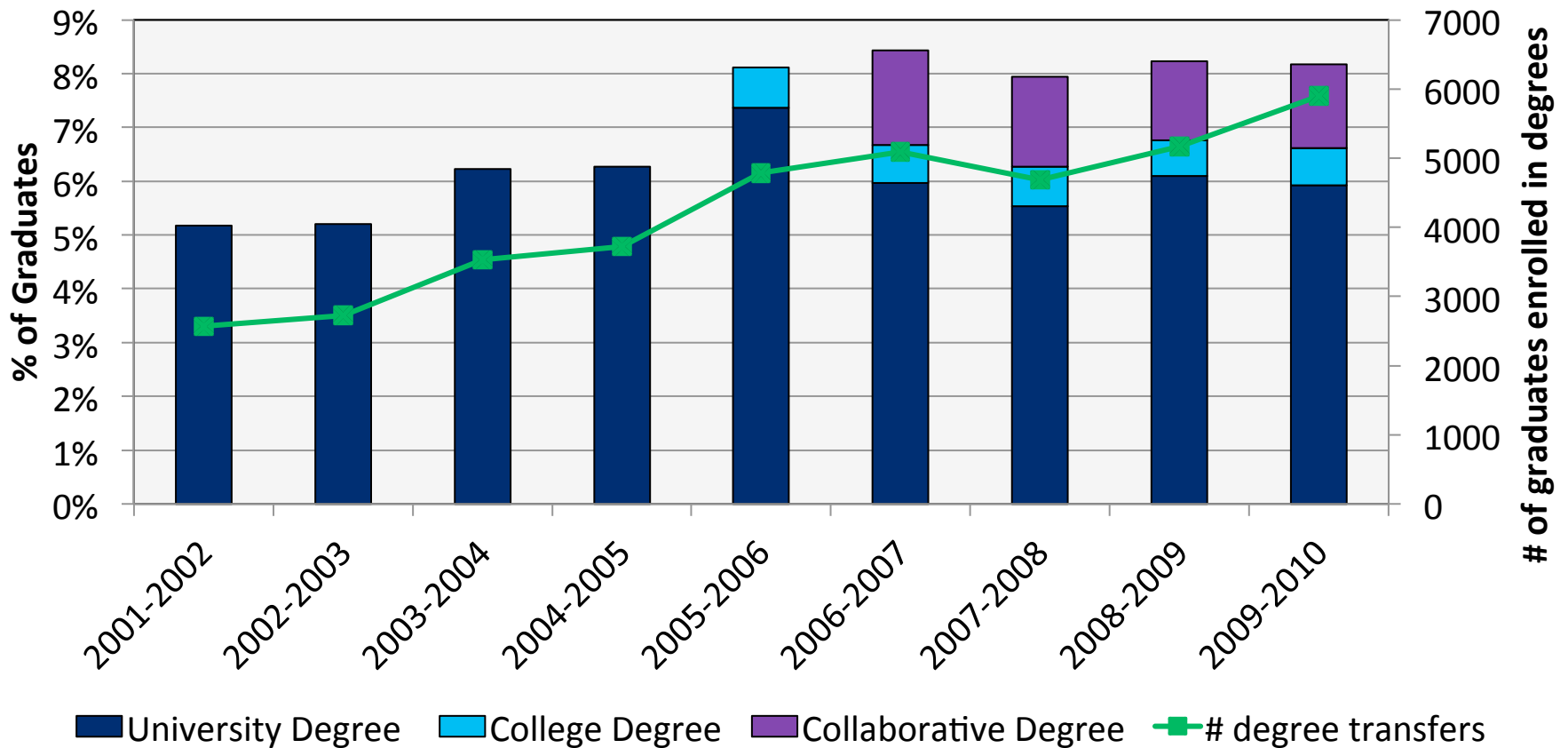

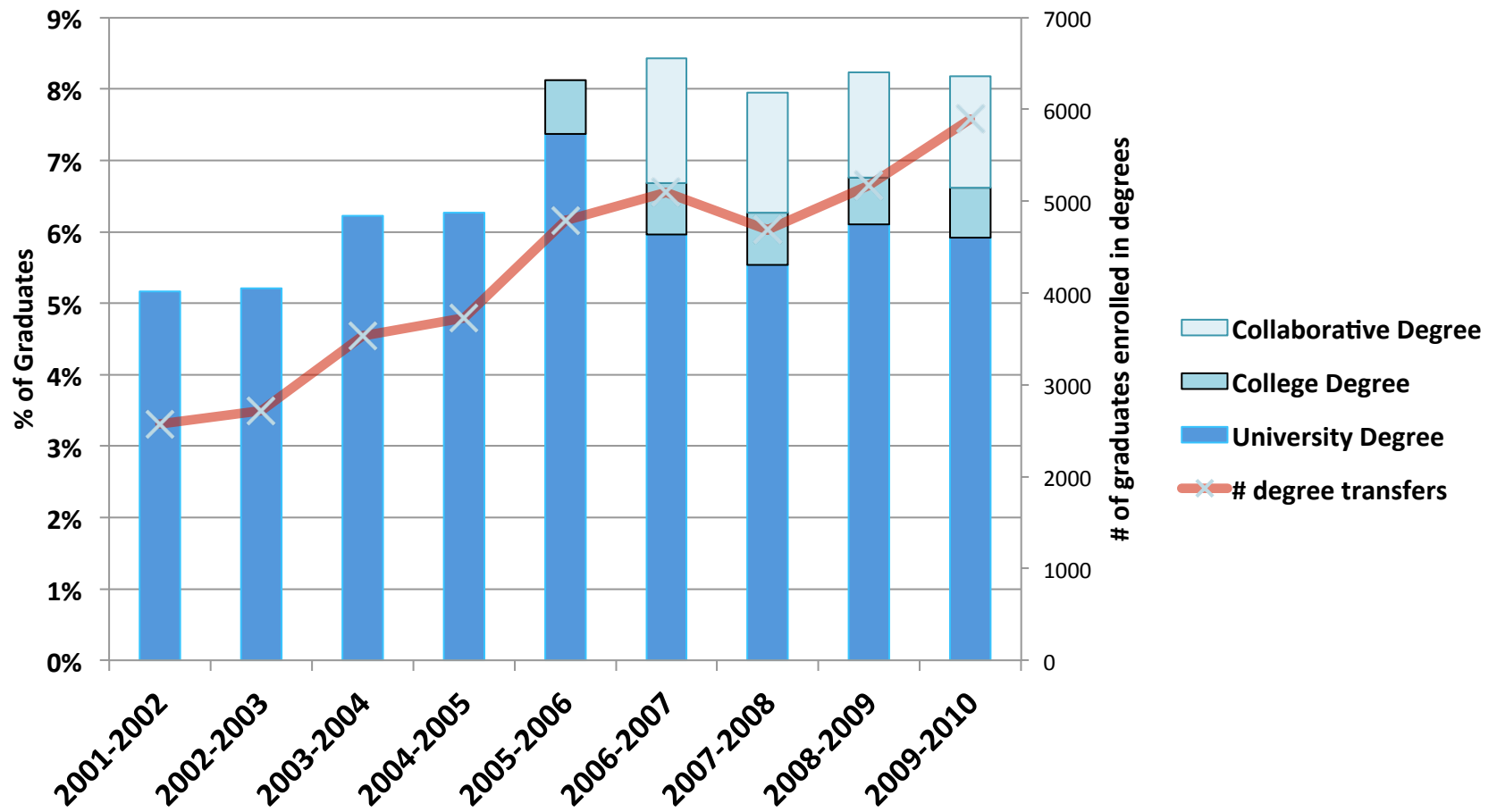
Transfer and Mobility: What do we know?

College Graduates Enrolled in Degree Programs within six months

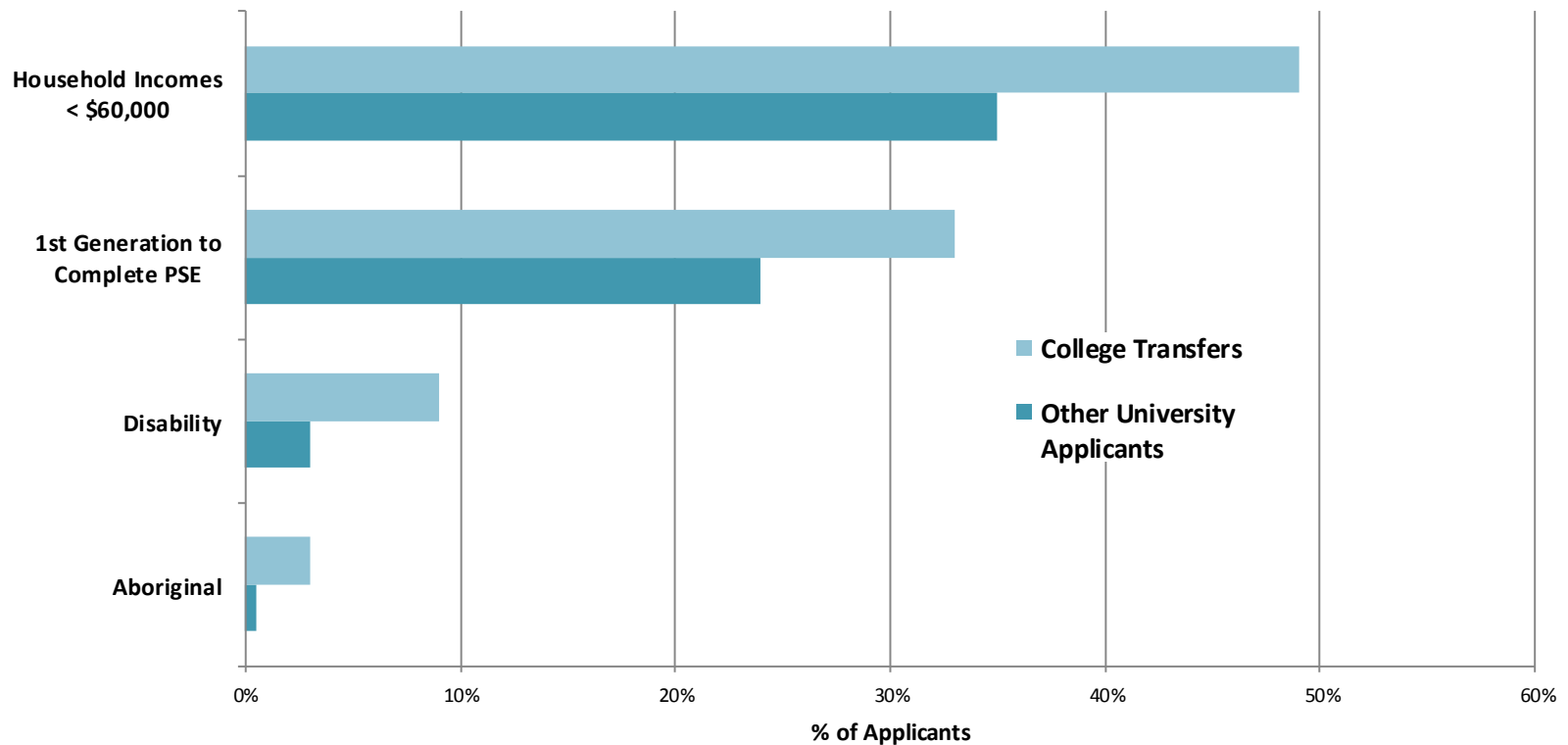


College graduates in degree programs on the increase

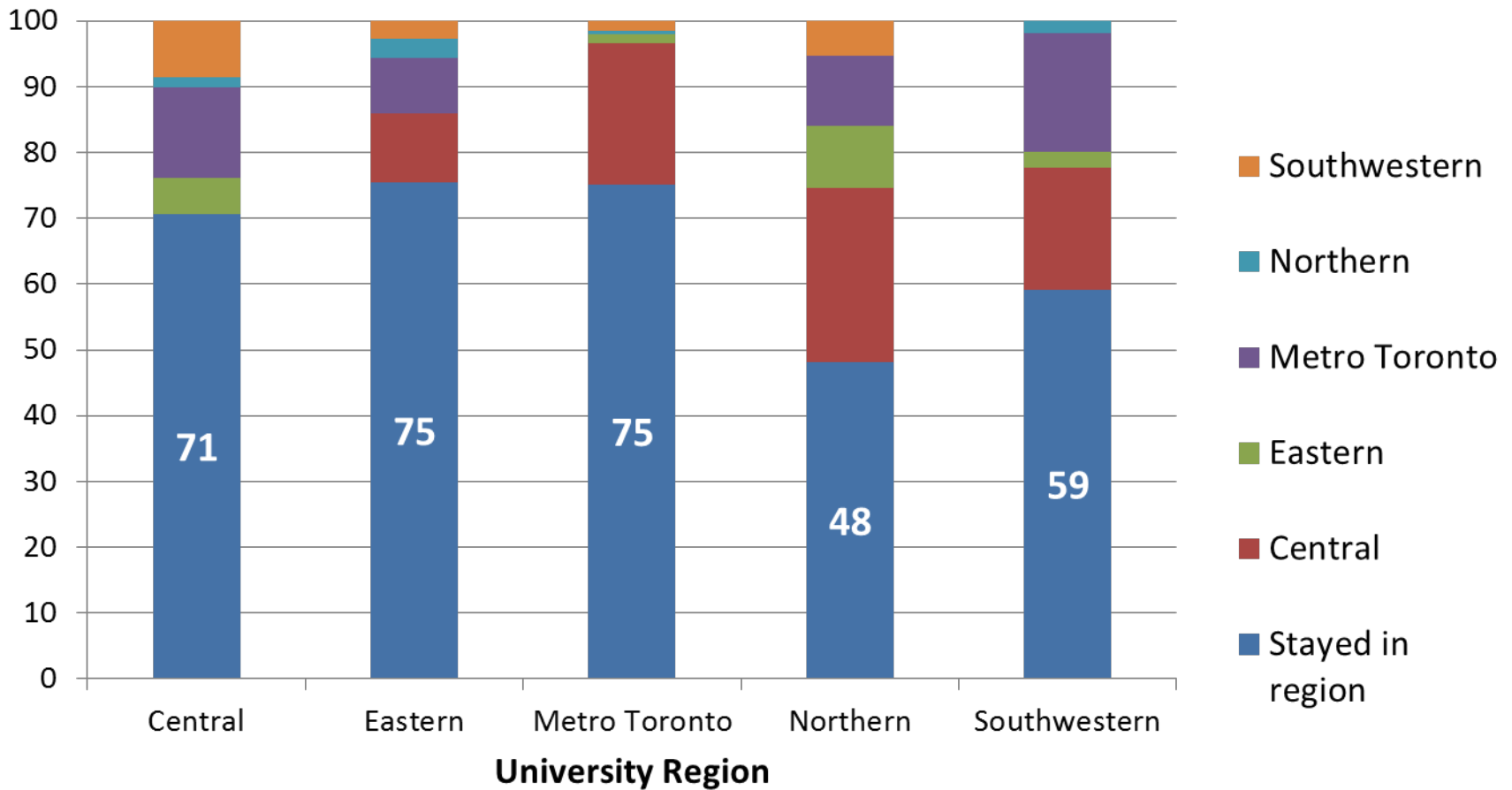


Transfer students more likely to be from underrepresented groups

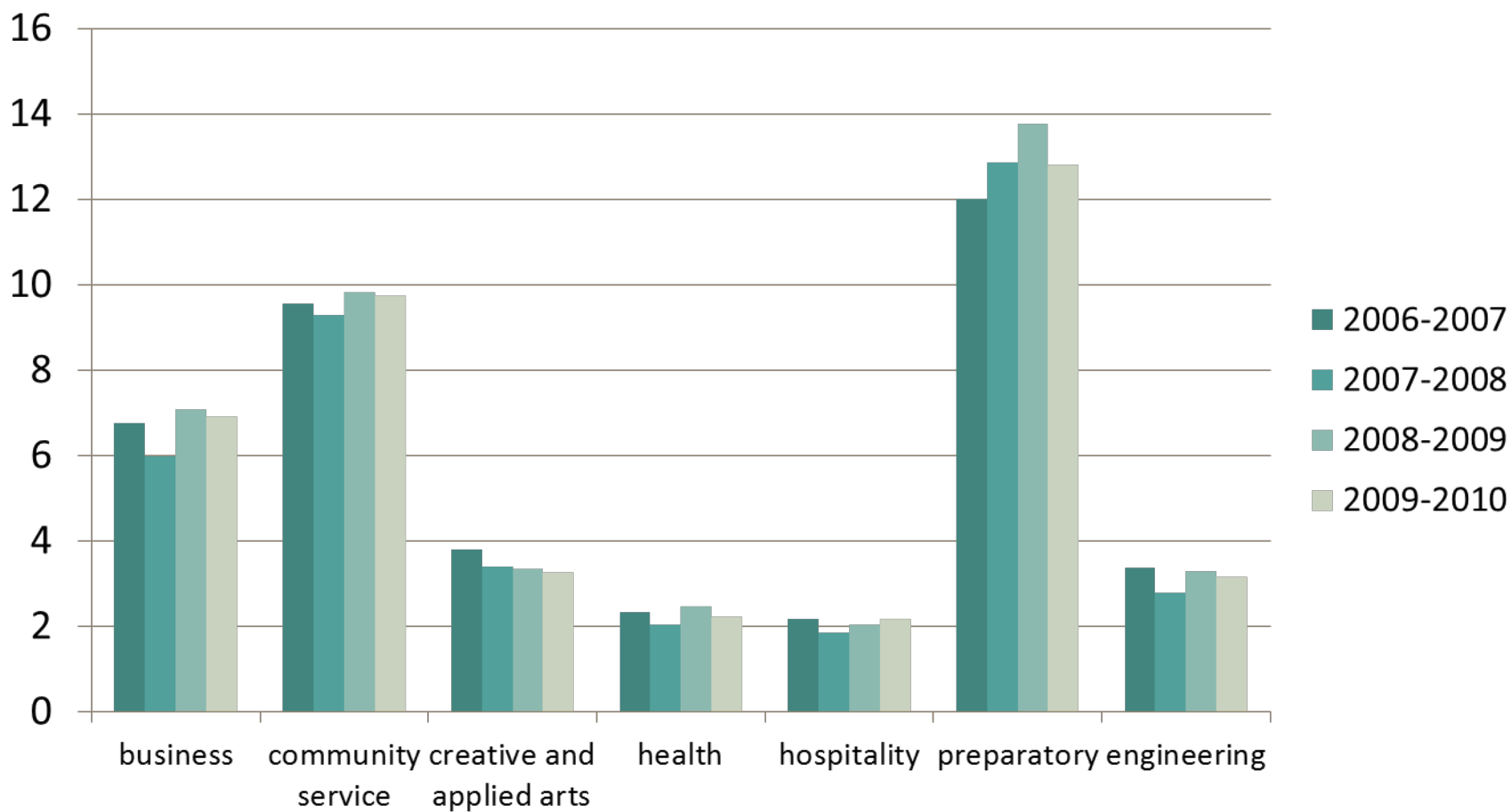
2009 College-University Transfer Applicants: Academica's University- College Applicant Survey



College graduates who transfer remain close to home

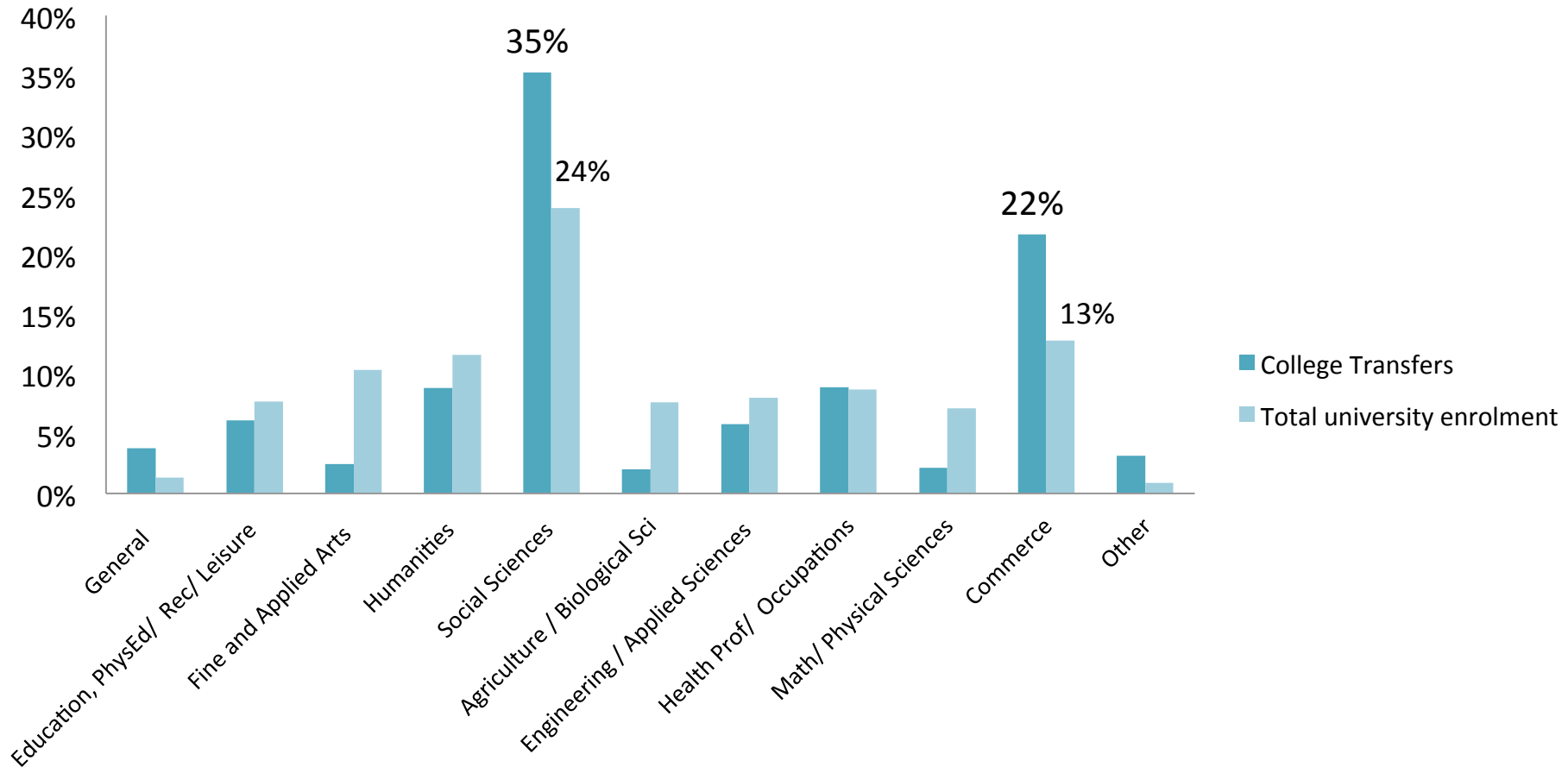


College students from preparatory programs most likely to transfer, followed by community services and business

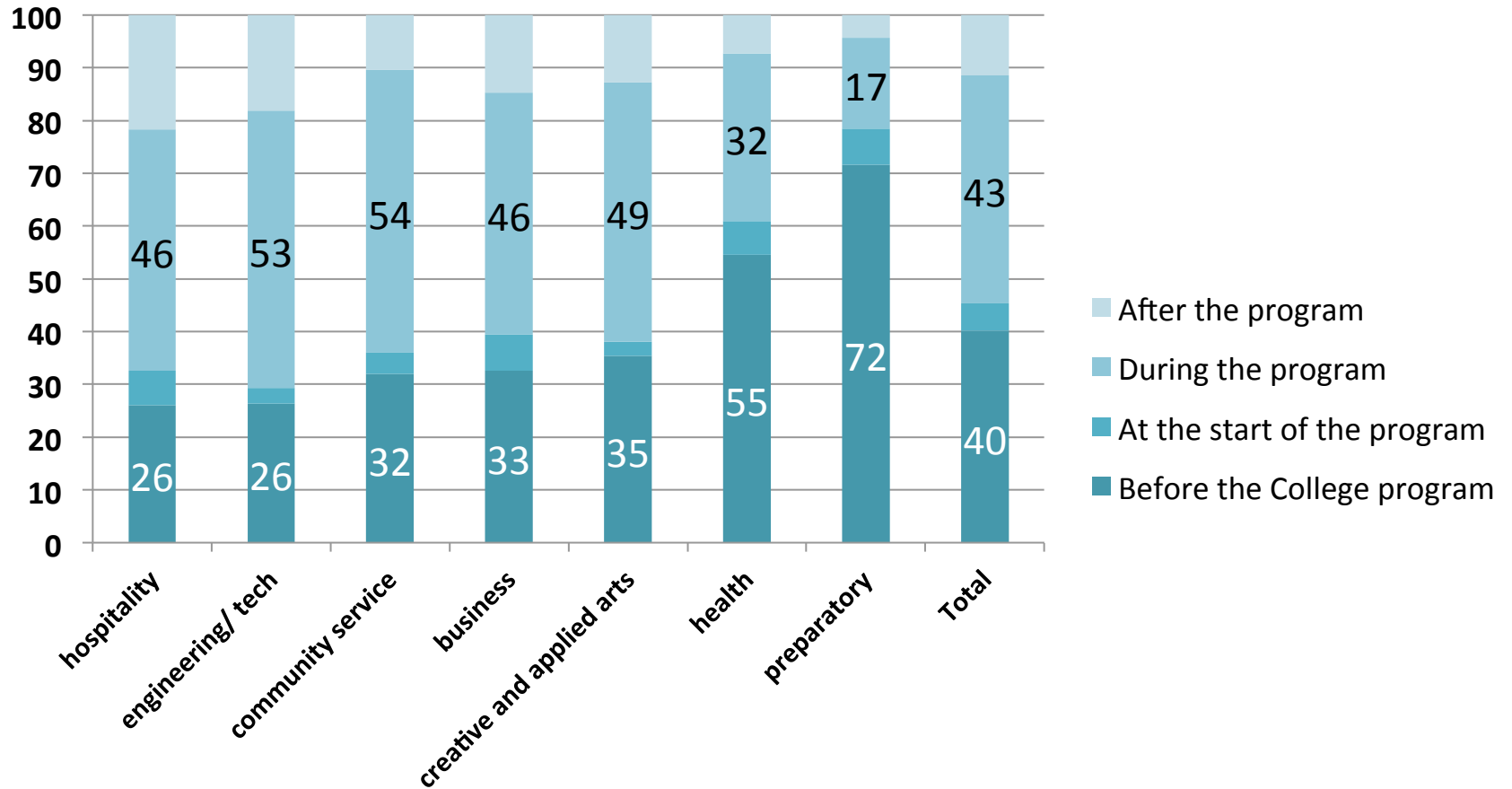


College transfers more likely to enter social sciences and business

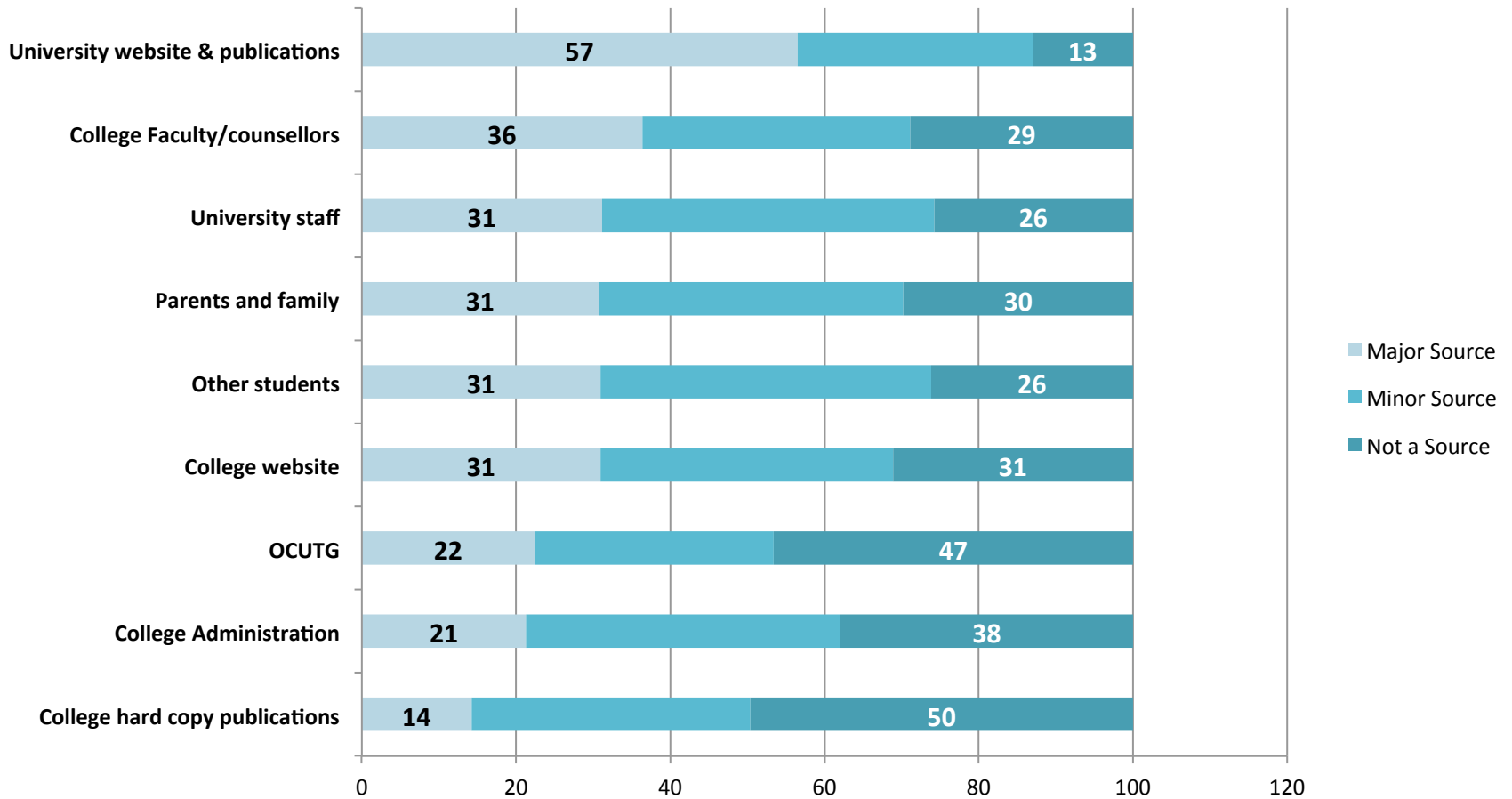
Distribution by field of study for college transfers relative to total university



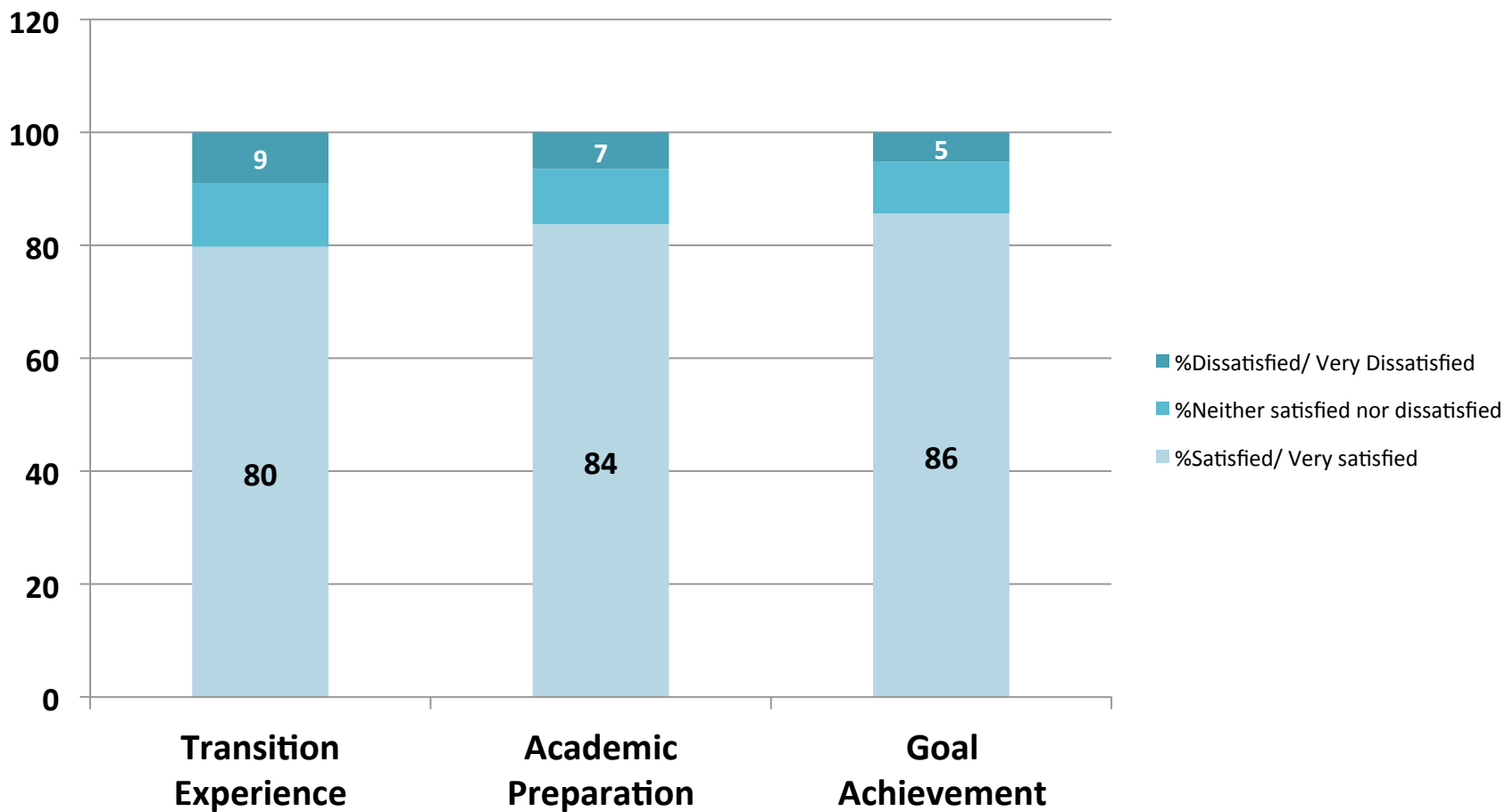
Decision to transfer often occurs after entering program



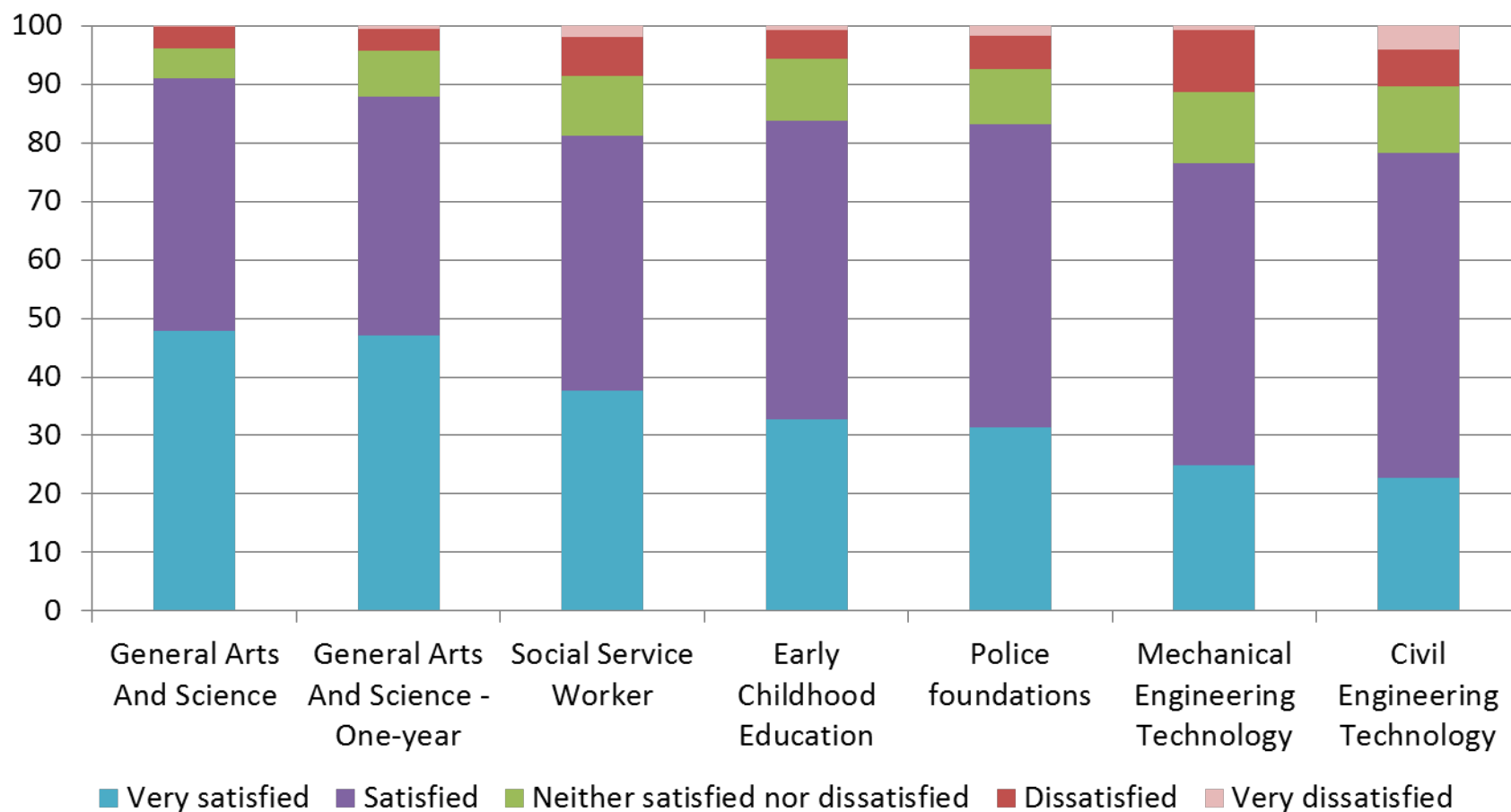
Majority of transfer students rely on university websites for information



Large majority of transfer students happy with experience



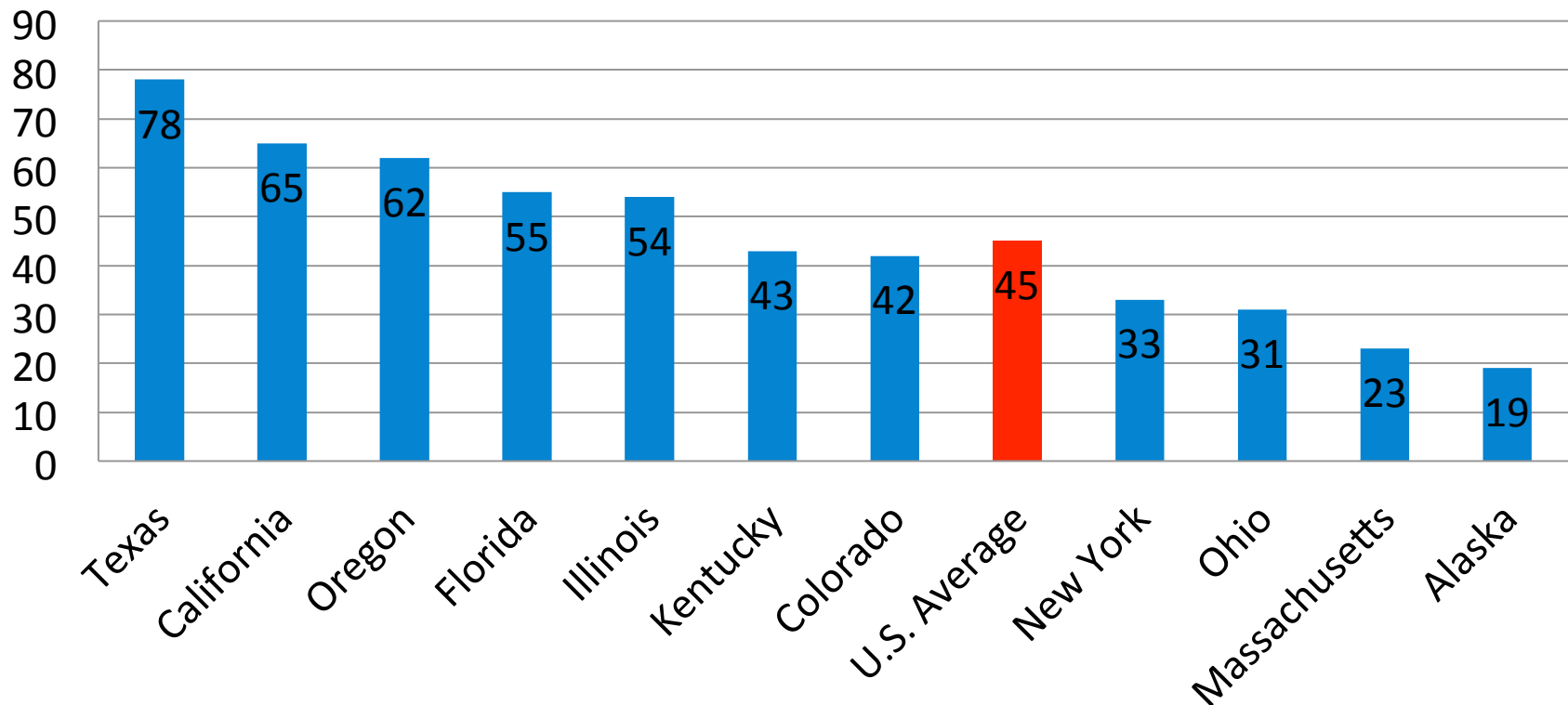
However, satisfaction with academic preparation differs by program



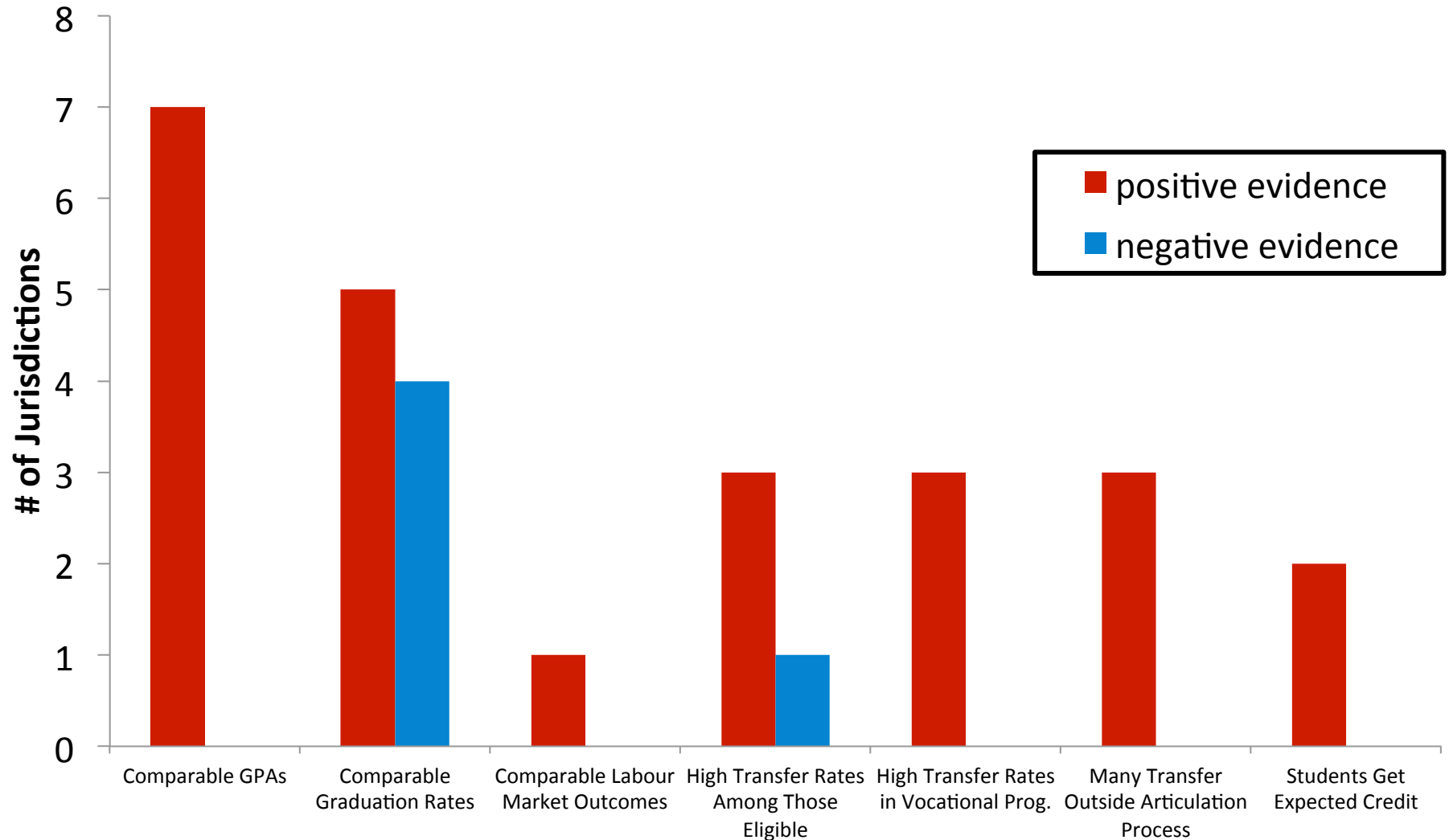
And a few lessons from other jurisdictions...
