



### What is an eportfolio?

The eportfolios of Mohawk graduates will be curated collections of digital artefacts that demonstrate graduates' abilities to communicate effectively, to collaborate productively, to think critically when solving challenging problems and to participate meaningfully in college, community, and global initiatives.

Artefacts that will be included in each graduate's eportfolio will include:

- graded assessments from their program of study;
- evaluations of their experiential learning opportunities;
- reflections by students on their learning;
- and, a record of their time and contributions to college, community, and global organizations.

### Important Notes about Vendor Demonstrations:

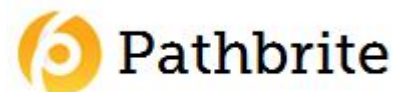
- ➔ These demonstrations are part of the eportfolio RFP process and vendors are scored as part of this selection process.
- ➔ Each vendor has only **one hour** to demonstrate their product and all vendors have been asked to follow the agenda.
- ➔ The agenda is tightly scripted to allow for a certain amount of time per agenda item, all to be completed in one hour – ten minutes have been allotted for questions at the end. Please note that, for this reason, they are unable to answer questions throughout. **Please hold questions until the question period at the end.**
- ➔ Vendors are demonstrating their **software only** and not the concept of eportfolios or other issues related to eportfolios at Mohawk. Please limit all questions to matters relating to the software and demonstration only.
